## CONFERENCE DIRECTIONS

### From the South

- Take Exit 28 (Brunswick) off I-295 North. This will put you on Pleasant Street-Route 1.
- Follow signs for "U.S. Route 1—Bath." (This will involve a left turn at laundromat.)
- Take the Cook's Corner exit off Route 1. Get in the left lane, and at the traffic light, turn left onto Bath Road.
- Medical Center Drive is one mile down Bath Road. Look for the Mid Coast Hospital sign and turn right.

### From the North

- Follow U.S. Route 1 across the Sagadahoc Bridge into Bath. Continue south.
- Take New Meadows Road Exit. Turn left at the end of the exit ramp. Proceed to stop sign at State Road. Turn Right.
- Medical Center Drive is 1.7 miles on your left. Turn left at the large Mid Coast Hospital sign.
